



# VVWRA Regional Septage Receiving Facility

## LIQUID WASTE HAULER DISCHARGE PERMIT APPLICATION

A VVWRA Interim Liquid Waste Hauler Discharge permit will be required before the Regional Septage Receiving Facility will allow discharge from any liquid waste hauler. The fee for this permit is \$500.00 per year. This fee must be received before any discharge will be accepted.

In addition to the permit fee, prior to acceptance of any septage discharge from a Permittee, the Permittee shall have placed on deposit with the Victor Valley Wastewater Reclamation Authority a minimum fee deposit ("Deposit") equal to the greater of (i) One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00); or (ii) the current septage rate multiplied by the total capacity of all trucks operated by Permittee which are registered under its Permit. **SPECIAL CONDITIONS:**

Liquid Waste haulers are hereby put on notice that all municipal code ordinances and state statutes will be vigorously enforced regarding discharge of hazardous or deleterious materials.

All haulers will be billed total capacity of each truck as indicated and verified by the San Bernardino County Environmental Health Department regardless of how full the truck is at the time of discharge. The cost of discharge at the Regional Septage Receiving Facility is \$0.0936 per gallon.

All truck drivers will be required to pull a sample to be tested for toxicity of their load. This will involve some waiting time for lab results. Any toxic lab analysis will be cause to reject the load.

No **OIL & GREASE** is accepted at the VVWRA Regional Septage Receiving Facility.

The hours for VVWRA Regional Septage Receiving Facility are from 7:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Hosing out of the truck tank will be permissible at VVWRA Regional Septage Receiving Facility at the time of discharge.
