General Manager

As VVWRA General Manager, Mr. Olds is responsible for the overall management, operation, maintenance, and capital improvements program for the Authority's 12 million gallons per day (MGD) wastewater treatment facility, pump stations, and 40.5 miles of interceptor sewers. VVWRA provides full tertiary treatment and Title 22 reclaimed water, serving a population of over 200,000 people in the High Desert. VVWRA is currently planning the development of two sub regional reclamation facilities and is under construction to expand the regional plant to 18 MGD in order to meet population growth in the Victor Valley. VVWRA is a Joint Powers Authority, with a service area of 216 square miles, including the communities of Victorville, Hesperia, Apple Valley, and the San Bernardino County Service Areas of Spring Valley Lake and Oro Grande. Mr. Olds joined VVWRA in April 2006 and supervises a staff of 41 employees.

Prior to moving to the Victor Valley, Mr. Olds served as General Manager of the Susanville Treatment Plant located in northern California. Mr. Olds holds a Bachelors degree in Ecology and a Master's degree in Water and Wastewater Utilization from Humboldt State University. The California certifications Mr. Olds has achieved include: Grade V Wastewater Operator, Grade IV Collection Systems Operator, Grade III Water Treatment Plant Operator, Grade II Distribution System Operator, and Grade I Laboratory Technician.

Mr. Olds is a member of the California Water Environment Association (CWEA). He is the Past President of the North Coast Section and has served as Treasurer for various CWEA conferences. Mr. Olds currently serves as Second Vice President of the Desert and Mountain Section (DAMS).

As the Laboratory Supervisor and principal analyst for VVWRA's state certified laboratory, she performs a variety of routine wet chemistry analyses on the various samples of wastewater and treated wastewater, calibrates and maintains laboratory equipment and instrumentation, trains and supervises laboratory and operations staff in sample collection and performance of laboratory analysis in accordance with the plant discharge permit. Gina also evaluates and reports laboratory data generated by the plant laboratory and subcontract laboratories to assist the operations staff in optimizing plant treatment processes and to ensure compliance with the discharge permit regulations. She serves as a member of the plant safety committee.

Gina discovered her interest in laboratory analysis as a high school student while preparing her first Science Fair project. She won a state award and a small scholarship for the project and began to consider a career as a laboratory analyst. While attending the University of California at Riverside (1988-1992), Gina worked as a Research Assistant for the UC Riverside Department of Entomology. In 1992, she earned her Bachelor of Science Degree in Biology and began working at C.L. Technology - Microbac Analytical (commercial laboratory) as the Sampling Coordinator. She held increasingly technical positions and was working as Microbiologist II when she left the company in 1995. Gina worked as a Laboratory Technician I at the City of Riverside Water Quality Control Plant from 1995 until 2000 at the city's 35 MGD wastewater treatment plant.
