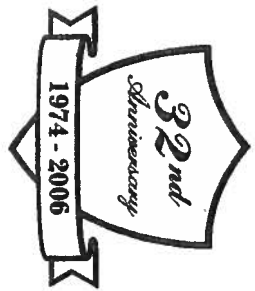

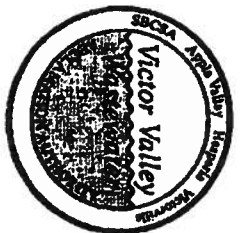

**GENERAL MANAGER** - (Competitive salary and benefits.) Plan, direct, organize, manage and coordinate administration and technical activities; plan and recommend programs as they relate to current and future wastewater activities; assure efficient and professional operation and maintenance of facilities; prepare annual budget and rates for Board. Must possess a Bachelor's degree in engineering, public administration, business administration or related field, plus five years of experience in municipal or government administration, experience in construction of various stages of pipeline, sewer line and wastewater treatment plants.

**DIRECTOR OF FINANCIAL SERVICES** - (Salary: \$101,263 - \$123,379 annually.) Planning, organizing and directing accounting functions of fixed assets accounting, investment/portfolio management, monthly financial and investment reports, construction financing and cash flow, preparing rate schedules, multi-year user charge and sewer connection fee projections, NEXUS documents, budget, depreciation schedules, fund management. Must possess four years experience managing government finances, including budget, a Bachelor's degree is preferred, registration as a CPA is preferred but not required.

**NETWORK SUPERVISOR** - (Salary: \$64,748 - \$78,889 annually.) Programs and maintains the local area network, recommends and implements policies, procedures, and standards relating to information systems activities, develops technical standards and procedures for system design, maintenance and operation. Must possess a Bachelor's degree in computer science or related field with six years computer/network experience plus supervisory experience.

**MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR** - (Salary: \$68,897 - \$83,945 annually.) Provide supervision and direction to maintenance personnel in the installation, maintenance, and repair of machinery, equipment, and infrastructure in wastewater treatment facilities to ensure proper operation and compliance with discharge requirements. Must possess an Associate's degree in science, engineering, or technology, a Grade III Mechanical Technologist or Grade IV Plant Maintenance Certificate issued by the California Water Environment Association.

**LABORATORY TECHNICIAN I** - (Salary: \$48,656 - \$59,283 annually.) Tests and analyzes processes and final effluent to ensure that the plant is operating within established limits; communicates the results to the operations department for the Victor Valley Wastewater Reclamation Authority (VWVRA). Must possess high school diploma or GED and Grade I Laboratory Analyst Certificate issued by the California Water Environment Association or American Water Works Association, with ability to obtain Grade II within one year of employment.

**TREATMENT PLANT OPERATOR GRADE IV OR V** - (Salary: \$59,356 - \$75,065 annually.) Operates complex treatment units, analyzes process control information, executes process control adjustments based on personal knowledge and experience, and assists in the maintenance of wastewater treatment facilities, pump stations, and the collection system. Must possess high school diploma or GED and Grade IV or Grade V Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator Certificate issued by the California State Water Resources Control Board.

**TREATMENT PLANT OPERATOR-IN-TRAINING** - (Salary: \$29,603 - \$36,068 annually.) Assist in the operation and maintenance of wastewater treatment facilities to ensure proper operation as well as compliance with discharge requirements. This is an entry-level position which provides training and development prior to obtaining a Treatment Plant Operator I position.
